On October 11, BSCC hosted event #8 in Bremerton, their last event of the year. Out of 143 entrants, two were PSMC drivers. Both drove Chevys and both won their classes! Nathan Provo won the Super Sport class in a 2003 Chevy Z06 with a 50.421. Dieter Beldi, driving a 2009 Chevy Cobalt, won the Medium Sedan Class with a 52.551. Kudos for this event go to Nathan Provo, who had the eighth top unindexed time of the day.

PSMC Wins Five Classes in Two Days

The last WWSCC events of the year were held on October 17 and 18 in Shelton. October 17 was the UWFSAE "Dawg Dash", which drew 51 entrants. Five of the entrants were PSMC members. Bob Bundy won Open Street in his '88 Mazda 323 GTX with a 55.890. I think he was in his Miata, but the results said 323.... In Stock D, Dieter Beldi won in his seldom-seen 2007 Mazdaspeed 3 with a 56.167. Nathan

Provo won Super Stock in a 2003 Chevy Z06 with a 59.026. In Street Tire-Touring, Glen Hernandez placed third in a '93 Miata with an STS-indexed time of 44.701. Having fun in Time Only PM was Dieter Beldi in his Mazdaspeed 3. He improved on his morning time by .72. Kudos for this event go to Glen Hernandez, who had the 10th top unindexed time of the day.

The very last autocross of the year was the ACE "Dogfight" on October 18. Out of the 49 entrants, five were PSMC members. In Stock D, Dieter Beldi won in his 2007 Mazdaspeed 3 with a 49.191. Alan Dahl placed fifth in PRO1 in a familiar-looking 2007 Mazdaspeed 3 with a DS-indexed time of 42.663. In Open Street, Bob Bundy won in his whining (uh oh!) '90 Miata with a 52.040. Glen Hernandez placed second in Street Tire-Touring in a '93 Miata with an STS-indexed time of 39.928. Having fun in Time Only was Bob Bundy, who improved on his morning time by a whopping 5.959. Guess he figured he should live it up before it's time to replace the transmission again.... Kudos for this event go to Bob Bundy and Glen Hernandez. Bob had the second top unindexed time of the day, while Glen had ninth.
